Worship & Wonder: An age appropriate worship service for our Kindergarten children at 11:00. Volunteers serve on a rotational basis. Curriculum, training, and supplies are provided.

Kids Worship 2: Age appropriate worship services for 3rd through 5th grades at the 9:30 hour and for 1st and 2nd grades at the 11:00 hour. Volunteer are needed as greeters and monitors.

Kids Worship 2 Tech Crew – Help once a month in the KW2 sound booth with audio/visual equipment necessary to provide our technology-driven Kids Worship 2 service. Techs can serve at either the 9:30 or 11:00 hours and training is provided.

H2O - Provide team support to help with 2nd—5th grades on Wednesday nights from 5:40 – 8:00 PM.
