About the Trip

This is our 10th year going to Guatemala and serving at Casa Bernabe orphanage. Niceville UMC has a unique relationship with this orphanage of over 150 children. We have taken over 250 from our area on this incredible mission opportunity over the last decade. It is an ideal trip for both first-timers and seasoned pros.

Who Can Participate?

Individuals 18 and older who have a great team attitude, a love for God and doing good works can participate. Demonstrated history of local church participation required. Students ages 15-17 can participate with at least one parent/legal guardian also present.

Skills Required

Almost any skills can be used at Casa Bernabe. Members of the team will be working with children on a daily basis. Some things the group may be involved with: construction work, working with the children, teaching, helping the staff, or working in the medical clinic. Once we are there, we simply do what they ask of us.

Number of Participants

The maximum number of people for the trip is 40. This trip is first-come first-serve, so sign up today!

Accommodations

The team will stay on campus at the Casa Bernabe orphanage. Cost of the trip will cover housing and food. There will be one leisure day with a trip to Antigua, the 500-year-old former capital of Central America. For more information about the orphanage, feel free to check out the website www.foce.org.

How to Reserve a Spot on the Team

Fill out the registration form (at right) and turn it in directly to Andrew Griffin or place it in his box in the church office during normal business hours. A \$500 deposit (checks payable to NUMC) is due at registration along with a copy of the front page of your passport. If you do not already have a passport, you should start that process immediately. A national background check must be conducted, and can be processed through the church. Deadline for remaining funds and background check is April 15.
