Keynote Speaker**



Dr. Jeannine Brabon
One Mission Society, Colombia

Jeannine Brabon is a Professor and Prison Minister in Colombia, where God has moved in mighty ways since 1989 in her pioneering work among hard core drug and crime lords.

Though few dared to visit Bellavista, Medellin's maximum-security prison noted for daily murders, Jeannine and a team of Colombian evangelists carried the Gospel inside. As a result, many lives have been transformed and the murders have dissipated. In 1992 Jeannine began the Bellavista Prison Bible Institute. Through this discipleship program, over 400 prisoners have graduated and now minister to other inmates all across the nation in the penitentiaries where they are.

Jeannine received the *World Peace Prize* by the World Methodist Council in July 2009. (Other recipients of this award have been notables like President Jimmy Carter and Nelson Mandela). Dr. Brabon is currently a professor of Biblical Hebrew at the University Foundation Biblical Seminary of Colombia, where she translated William LaSor's two-volume Hebrew grammar and lessons into Spanish. She is also involved in evangelism, discipleship, and training national church leadership.
